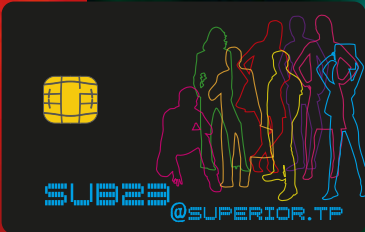

What is the sub23?

The sub23 is a travel card for higher education students, up and including the age of 23, that offers discounts on travel passes. For medical and architectural students, the card is called “23+1” and it is valid until the age of 24.

Who can get it?

sub23 | 25%

Higher education students who do not benefit from the Higher Education Direct Social Action Support.

sub23 | 60% Direct Social Action

Students who benefit from the Higher Education Direct Social Action Support.

How to apply?

- Identity card
- Proof of enrolment (sub23 travel pass declaration valid for the current school year, issued by the college/university in the approved form).

- Identity card
- Proof of enrolment (Sub23 travel pass declaration valid for the current school year, issued by the college/university in the approved form, and stating that the student benefits from the Higher Education Direct Social Action Support).

Cost of the card

Standard delivery (10 weekdays)	3.50 €
Express delivery (1 weekday)	6.00 €

Card renewal

To continue using the sub23 pass, the card profile must be renewed at the beginning of each school year (by presenting the required documents for each type of discount).

If you have a valid sub23 card, go to the following locations:

- Customer Care Spaces (Campo Grande and Marquês de Pombal stations);
- Navegante support centre (Alameda, Entre Campos and Jardim Zoológico stations);

- Universidade de Lisboa - Cantina Velha, from 19 to 25 September, from 11am to 3pm.

Recommended fares

The sub23 benefit applies to most travel passes in the Lisbon region.

For traveling in the city of Lisbon using the metro, bus, tram and train (CP) we recommend the Navegante municipal or the Navegante metropolitano travel passes.
