# Travel guide 1) Plan your journey and ensure you have a valid travel ticket

Before starting your metro journey to the match, check its location and plan your route accordingly.

Check the available travel ticket options and choose the one that best suits your needs.

We recommend the following occasional tickets:

Valid for unlimited journeys on the Metro and Carris networks (bus, tram, lift and funicular), for 60 minutes, starting from the first to the last validation. Does not allow consecutive uses on the Metro.

• Carris/Metro day pass – 7,00€ Valid for unlimited journeys for 24 hours after the first validation on all Carris (bus, tram, lift and funicular) and Metro networks.

• Zapping – 1,66€ (cost of the journey on the Metro)
Pre-paid transport ticket, where the value of the journey is deducted from the card's balance. Minimum top-up of  $\in$ 3 and maximum of  $\in$ 40. Also valid on the following operators: Carris; CP/Comboios de Portugal; Transtejo Soflusa and Carris Metropolitana.

Always validate your ticket. Ticket validation is mandatory!

## 2) Follow safety and courteous behaviour

- Follow the instructions provided by Metro staff or security personnel.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited on metro trains and within metro facilities.
- · Transporting hazardous or potentially dangerous items such as glass bottles, alcoholic beverages, fireworks, etc., is not permitted.
- · Do not cross the yellow line located along the edge of the boarding platform.
- Allow passengers to exit the train before boarding.
- $\cdot$  Do not board or alight the train after the audio door-closing announcement.
- · If you require assistance, please use the "help point" available at the fare gate line or ticket machines.
